Stays are made sweeter as guests are roped in to create Chocolate Macarons, Apple Pie, and Cookies glazed with Royal Icing. Thereafter, they will enjoy a relaxing three-tier Afternoon Tea set at The Courtyard with free-flowing tea or coffee.

Witness the finer points of the craft cocktail revolution at the **Craft Cocktails** class, conducted on the third Saturday of every month. Filled with all the trappings of an artisanal tipple venue, Post Bar is where guests will embark on a journey into housemade infusions, botanicals and craft spirits. Our resident mixologist will shake up three postal-themed drinks inspired by their provenance.

The Airmail – 32900 Santa Cruz employs brown butter rum, while the Fizz – 70130 New Orleans is a refreshing combination of pineapple-earl grey vodka and ginger ale. A hint of caffeine is evident in the Martinez – 10036 New York, made with a base of coffee vermouth. A fourth cocktail rounds things up in the form of a liquid strawberry shortcake dessert. In between drinks, nibble on complementary bites such as Canned Spicy Prawns, Seared Tuna with Guacamole, and Lamb skewers.

and Ratte Potato Quiche, Crispy Chilli Crabmeat Buns, Kueh Lapis and Petite Nyonya Kuehs.
