1. Cars at Fullerton Concours d'Elegance

Highlights of some of the notable cars slated to be on display:

	Name & Year	Background
1.	1934 Austin Seven Ulster Special 	<p>The Austin Seven Ulster Special sports a special bodykit called "Ulster". It is aluminium-bodied with no doors. It was highly popular in the 1930s with its sporty body while remaining affordable.</p>
2.	1935 Mercedes-Benz 500K 	<p>One of the rare Right Hand Drive (RHD) examples, the elegantly styled body is fitted with white-wall tyres, and is not to be missed during the show.</p>
3.	1958 Porsche 356A Speedster 	<p>The only Right Hand Drive (RHD) Porsche 356A Speedster in the Southeast Asian region (about 20+ RHD Porsche 356A were ever built).</p>

4.	<p>1961 Rolls-Royce Silver Cloud II</p> 	<p>One of the three recently restored cars in the Rolls-Royce fleet of The Fullerton Hotel Singapore to be unveiled at the show, the Rolls-Royce Silver Cloud II features wood trims restored by David Boucher, a famous Rolls-Royce bespoke wood trim designer.</p>
5.	<p>1972 BMW 3.0 CSi</p> 	<p>A pristine 2-door coupe with an engine displacement of 2986cc, twin carburettor, the homologation special BMW E9 3.0 CSi was an important car to the BMW brand in the 1970s as it was very successful in the racing world.</p>
6.	<p>1973 Triumph Stag V8</p> 	<p>A 2+2 Sports Tourer styled by Italian designer Giovanni Michelotti, the beautifully designed Triumph Stag was briefly featured in the James Bond film 'Diamonds Are Forever'.</p>

7.	<p>2018 Rolls-Royce Phantom</p> 	<p>The 8th Gen Rolls-Royce Phantom continues to be the ultimate luxury car in the segment, with even more refinements made for the interior. Visitors will get to view the car up close to see the exquisite build quality of the car.</p>
8.	<p>2018 Ferrari Portofino</p> 	<p>To be launched in Singapore this year, visitors will be among the first to view this piece of art at Clifford Pier.</p>
